## Personal Device Agreement (BYOD)

I want my child to bring their own Chromebook to school for use in the classroom learning programme. I understand (please tick each statement):

- All Chromebooks brought to school are my child's responsibility and the insurance for the device is my responsibility.
- The school holds no responsibility for any loss or damage which might occur.
- That teachers will provide a locked cupboard in which my child may place their device when it is not in use.
- My child will bring their Chromebook to school each day fully charged.
- Devices brought to school are for the use of my child. The school adheres to a 'sharing screen' concept, whereby my child may share his/her screen with others. In collaborative group work there may be 2 – 3 children working together, however my child will be in charge of entering information into his/her device.
- Children will use cloud based applications such as Google G-Suite for file management and are allowed to access this at home with parental permission.
- My child will still be expected to use pen and paper as part of their learning in addition to the purposeful use of their device.
- Rules governing the use of any school-owned device will apply to student-owned devices while they are at school. This includes adherence to the Copyright Act and school cyber safety policies and our Responsible Use of Digital Technologies Agreement.
