Visual Art Exhibits: All three of these pieces will be created at school - no home requirements.

Please send the following items to school in a named container. This garden must be created at school so please do not send any items pre-assembled, however children can plan their design at home. It could be a good idea for your child to bring in a drawing or inspiration pictures to help with creating their garden at school. <i>Please bring:</i> A selection of plant-life to make your sea-themed garden. These could be weeds, flowers, greenery and/or succulents. A selection of unique items to make your garden look like it belongs in or by the sea ie, painted rocks, marbles, shells, plastic sea creatures, furniture made from sticks. |
